PRESS NOTE

For the term 2010-12, elections were held for six posts of the Association of Industries, Gangyal on 24TH September, 2010. A new team of office bearers headed by S. Tejwant Singh Reen, President was elected to manage the affairs of the Association henceforth. The polling was held in a very cordial way while S. Tejwant Singh Reen secured 379 votes, out of 571 votes polled, Sh. S. B. Abrol secured 347 votes for the post of Senior Vice President. Similarly, Sh.
